You will work closely with the reservations and marketing team to ensure accurate and effective promotional campaigns, and you will provide close support to the Guest Experience Team to ensure our clients' stays run smoothly.

You will bring bags of creativity and a visionary, yet methodical brain – capable of pinpointing the wow-factor of a place and communicating this through beautifully written descriptions, while making sure the contracts are accurate and up to date.

KEY PRODUCT MANAGER DUTIES

- Work closely with the General Manager to pre-approve new villas and experiences against key benchmarks and growth plans
- Carry out listing visits, noting features and facilities with attention to detail
- Move new product through the onboarding process in agreed timeframes
- Negotiate prices and terms with suppliers before securing contracts
- Continual review of website and client communications to ensure 100% accuracy
- Oversee annual price & service-level reviews, analysis of booking & enquiry data, competitor analysis and make proposals to maximise company performance
- Maintain close relationships with suppliers, finding creative ways to help foster loyalty, create special offers/promotions, present villas to the highest standards and enable swift troubleshooting
- Write creative descriptions for the web and accurate factsheets to inform marketing and reservations
- Brief new photo shoots to capture the 'wow factor' of each property/experience
- Provide updates/training to Marketing & Reservations to help generate sales and inform them of commercial changes



- Monitor the quality of product on sale and support colleagues with any issues which may arise, assist with escalated customer complaints
- Maintain accurate SOPs and guidelines covering the department's key tasks.
- Capture content for Social Media when visiting villas and destinations
- Work closely with the Product Assistant to ensure CRM, booking systems and website are 100% accurate at all times

DETAILS OF ROLE

This role is ideally suited to someone living in Spain in one of our key destinations (existing or planned) who is registered self-employed in Spain.
